Property Report

The Property For Sale Listing has generated a lot of interest. The website, <http://www.tennessevalleyroad.com> has had over 200 visitors in the first 6 days. Four different developers have shown interest in the site. One of the developers has expressed interest in building two 3000 square foot homes which is acceptable under the current zoning, and could be developed fairly quickly. The Rotary Housing group has met with Marlene Rice, Jim Sides, and myself and would like to develop Affordable Senior Housing on our site. They have since met with Marin County Planning staff which was very supportive of Rotary Housing vision for the property. This will take a lengthy community process. The Rotary Housing initially hoped to present an offer to the Church quickly. However, Tam Valley residents have already expressed significant concerns regarding potential new developments on other sites and their impact on traffic. Rotary Housing is in the process of communicating with Tam Valley residents to confirm that they would have some local support before making an offer. Realistically, it may be several more weeks before Rotary Housing will be confident that they can ultimately obtain approvals to develop affordable senior housing on our site. A "For Sale" sign is being fabricated and should be erected on the Property soon. Gary Glover
