The angel said to his heavenly attendants, "Take away the filthy clothes this man is wearing." Then he said to Joshua, "I have taken away your sin and will give you new clothes to wear."

(Zechariah 3:1, 3-4)



The book commonly referred to as the Old Testament was originally written in the ancient form of Hebrew. Rather than call it the Old Testament, many who have studied Hebrews prefer to call it the Hebrews Bible or the Hebrew Scriptures.

Anyway, the word 'Satan' is a Hebrew word. Sometimes it is translated 'adversary'. A more accurate translation is 'accuser'. When serpent appears in Genesis three, one can see that the serpent does seem to have some accusatory qualities. Genesis 3:5 records, God said that because he knows that when you eat it, you will be like God and know what is good and what is bad."

In Zechariah 3 we see Satan as 'accuser'. In that passage Satan brings accusations against the figure of Joshua. Joshua is wearing filthy clothes. The symbolism seems to be that Joshua is covered with sin. It is as if Satan is saying to God, "How can Joshua be one of your people with all this sin?"

Rather we are defined by the new robes that have been placed on us. Like Joshua, we have been given new robes to wear. John, in the book of Revelation, states it this way,

"Who are these people dressed in white robes, and where do they come from?" . . . "These are the people who have come safely through the terrible persecution. They have washed their robes and made them white with the blood of the Lamb. . . . Never again will they hunger or thirst; neither sun nor any scorching heat will burn them, because the Lamb, who is in the center of the throne, will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of life-giving water. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes." (Revelation 7)

No! We are not defined by our spots or dirt on our clothes. Rather, we are defined by the one who makes us clean, and cleans us again tomorrow.
