Neither New Year's Eve nor New Year's Day are church holidays per se. They are non-religious holidays. By the time you read this brief article, many of you and your friends will have stayed up late and, consequently, slept in late. You will have welcomed the New Year with your friends and maybe even with Chandon family or one of their relatives.

However, on the calendar for the church year, January 1 is a minor festival. It is the observance of the "Name of Jesus". It was the Jewish custom at the time of the birth of Jesus that on the eight day male children would be circumcised and named. Since the birth of Jesus is celebrated on December 25th, the eight day following would be January 1. (For the record, most bible scholars think it is unlikely that Jesus was born on December 25. The odds are 1 in 365.)

This minor festival is seen as the Son of God submitting to the law of God. As all newborn Jewish males submitted to God's law on the eight day, so Jesus did the same.

There are many aspects to this observance. One aspect is that God truly became one of us by submitting to the same commandments of God as the rest of us. The author of Hebrews writes:

"For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." (Hebrews 4:15-16)

I guess I would say the comfort of this festival is to remind us we are not alone on our journey. As we face a new year, we are reminded of the one who became one of us for us and continues to journey with us.

It goes back to that bumper sticker logic. "We do not know what the future holds, but we know who holds the future."

The Festival of the Name of Jesus reminds us, "We do not know what the future holds" however, we know the one who walks with us into the future.
