Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

N. T. Wright in his book, <u>Surprised by Hope</u>, notes that most Christians equate the word "resurrection" with "life after death" or "going to heaven". His book is a reminder that resurrection is not only a future reality but also a present reality.

This year marks the 35th anniversary of the eruption of Mount Saint Helens. I remember six years after the eruption, Nancy and I drove to the mountain. The forest up to the mountain was thick with cedars, ferns and moss among other plants. Then we drove around one bend and suddenly it was all desert.

We drove back to Mount Saint Helens eighteen years after the eruption and the area was very green. It was not the thick vegetation it once was but life was returning. This once desolate area was experiencing its own resurrection.

This month we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from death. We also believe that when we die, one day Christ will return and raise us to new life.

However, resurrection is also a present reality. It gives us hope in our present world. It reminds us that whatever struggles we are experiencing, Christ has given us new life. Our struggles do not have the final word. Christ does. That word is life. Even new life in our present existence.


