Truly Organic Bread

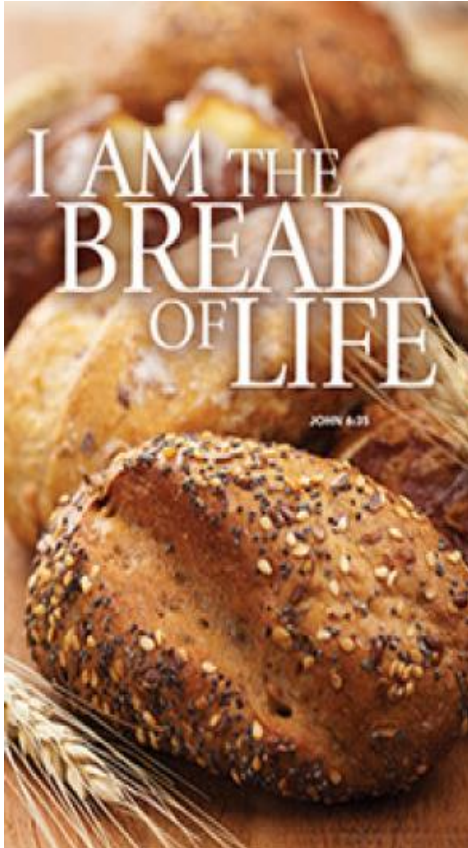
Jesus answered them, "Very truly, I tell you, you are looking for me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For it is on him that God the Father has set his seal." (John 6:26-27)

Dear Friends

I was in Safeway this week. A woman with her shopping cart pointed at some fruit and said to her son, "That's a good price." Her son looked at the fruit and replied, "But it's not organic."

This passage made me think of that small encounter. Jesus tells the people they wanted more bread because they were full. They didn't care what it was just as long as they were full. Jesus tells the people he himself is certified by God as the one who will give the food that endures to eternal life.

I looked up what makes bread organic. I did not find a specific definition of organic bread but I did find what certifies food as organic:



- When a grower or processor is certified organic, a public or private organization verifies that it meets or exceeds defined standards. These standards include:

- Land on which organic food or fibers are grown must be free of prohibited substances for three years prior to certification.

- Farmers and processors must keep detailed records of methods and materials used in growing or producing organic products.

- All methods and materials are annually inspected by a third-party certifier.

- All farmers and handlers are required to maintain written organic plans detailing their management practices. (Sourced from <http://countrychoicenaturals.com>)

Jesus' point, it seems to me, was that the people didn't care who fed them but merely cared that their stomachs were full.

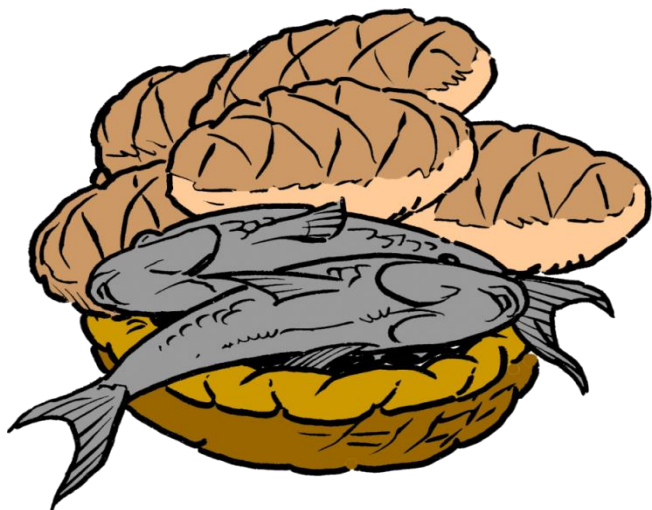
Some of us are like those people. We don't care what we are fed just as long as we are fed. Others of us hunger but we want more than just to have our bellies filled.
