# Leap to Faith

(Or Three Great Danes)

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. - Hebrews 11:1

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Nancy and I have a friend, Lucinda. She and her partner, Steve, went back to visit New England toward the end of August.

She is best known for being the owner of T Rex, a Great Dane (*Great Dane #1*) who accompanies her around Sausalito. She makes a living being an artist. (As an aside, if any of you have \$12,000.00 she painted a beautiful three panel piece of the waters of the bay I would love to own. Maybe my birthday. Shameless, I know.) Anyway, Lucinda has an artist's view of her surroundings.

That helps to explain a curious photograph she posted on Facebook from her trip to New England. It is her pointing to two signs. One sign is a yellow diamond shape road sign which says, "DEAD END". Next to the road sign is a green and white rectangular street sign which says, "JESUS Valley Road". (See the picture below)

I thought the photograph rather humorous so I asked her about it. She told me she thought there was some type of message there. Maybe, "There's a dead end but with Jesus you can plow through the dead end." Not bad. Not bad.



About the same time her photograph appeared on Facebook I started reading a book. The title of the book is **The Making of the Atomic Bomb** by Richard Rhodes.

At the beginning of the book, Rhodes reviews the life of the remarkable Danish physicist Niels Bohr (Great Dane #2). Rhodes mentions the profound influence the Danish Theologian Soren Kierkegaard (Great Dane #3) had on Bohr's view of life and science.

Lucinda's photograph and Rhodes' book got me to think more about Great Dane #3, Soren Kierkegaard.

Kierkegaard wrote of a concept he called a "Leap to Faith". Very simplistically it means something like, "One can think about all the teachings of the Christian faith and whether to believe them or not. However, ultimately eventually one has to take a leap to faith, a leap to belief".

Perhaps using the two road signs in Lucinda's photograph, "When one comes to a dead end, one can only take that leap to faith or that leap to Jesus."

Sounds corny doesn't it

Yet as one reads the New Testament letter of Hebrews, especially chapter 11, one sees a small catalogue of people who did just that. They reached a dead end in their own lives but trusted that God's promises would overcome those dead ends. They took that leap to faith (Or as many people put it, "Leap of Faith").

Still corny?

I am often amazed at our own lack of faith.

Many of us look back at a time and world we thought once existed. It is no longer there. We feel things are at an end. We wonder where is God?

At least I have these feelings at times.

But then there is that small event or that one person who reminds me things are not at an end. God is here. God is active. The "Dead End" disappears.

"Thanks be to God who gives us the victory through Jesus Christ!" (Romans 8:39)
